(part 4): 'creation of naturally perfect breasts'

In Part 4 of our series, Sydney plastic surgeon **Dr Steven Liew** explains the criteria for creating a natural-looking breast enhancement.

According to Sydney plastic surgeon Dr Steven Liew, breast augmentation isn't just a step toward changing how you look; it also represents a transformation in how you feel about your body.

Whilst it's a comparatively simple surgical procedure, to achieve a consistent, predictable and aesthetically-pleasing result, artistry, aesthetic sense, symmetry and balance are required.

Whilst each woman has an individual preference in terms of breast size, fullness and shape, the majority of women requesting breast augmentation surgery also want their breasts to look 'natural'. 'In short, what most women want is the "creation of naturally perfect breasts,"' says Dr Liew.

The 'creation of naturally perfect breasts' includes all the criteria of attractive breasts. They should be in proportion to the patient's body size; have adequate perkiness, especially in the upper part of the breast; and have adequate cleavage and outer breast fullness to camouflage the outline of the ribcage.

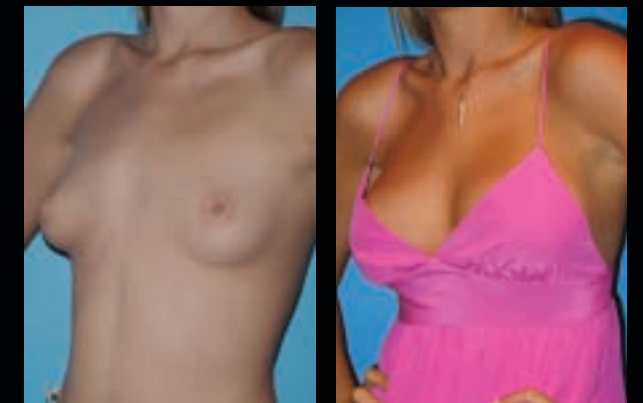

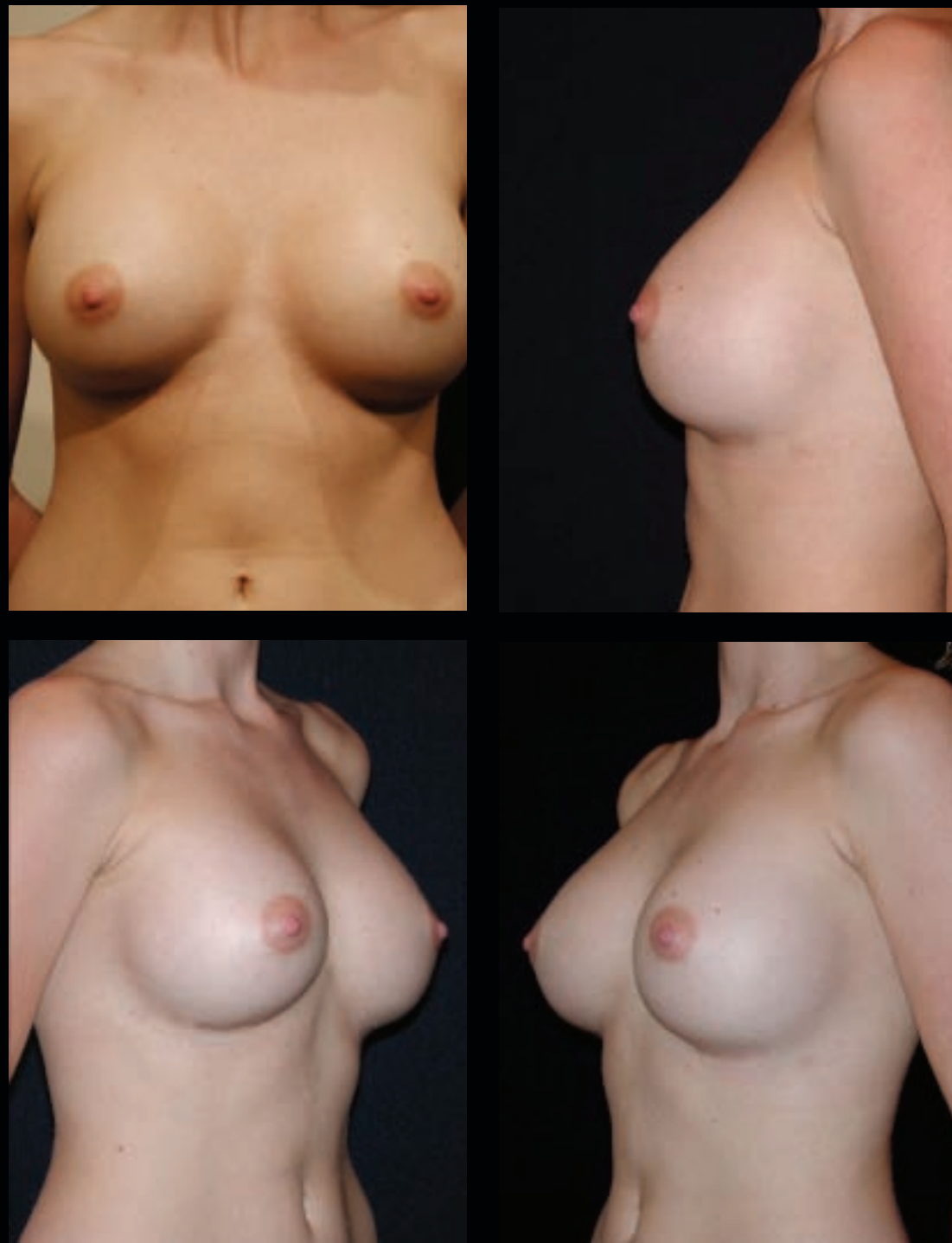
